Participants from each district will receive an application tool kit.* These easy-to-use kits provide:

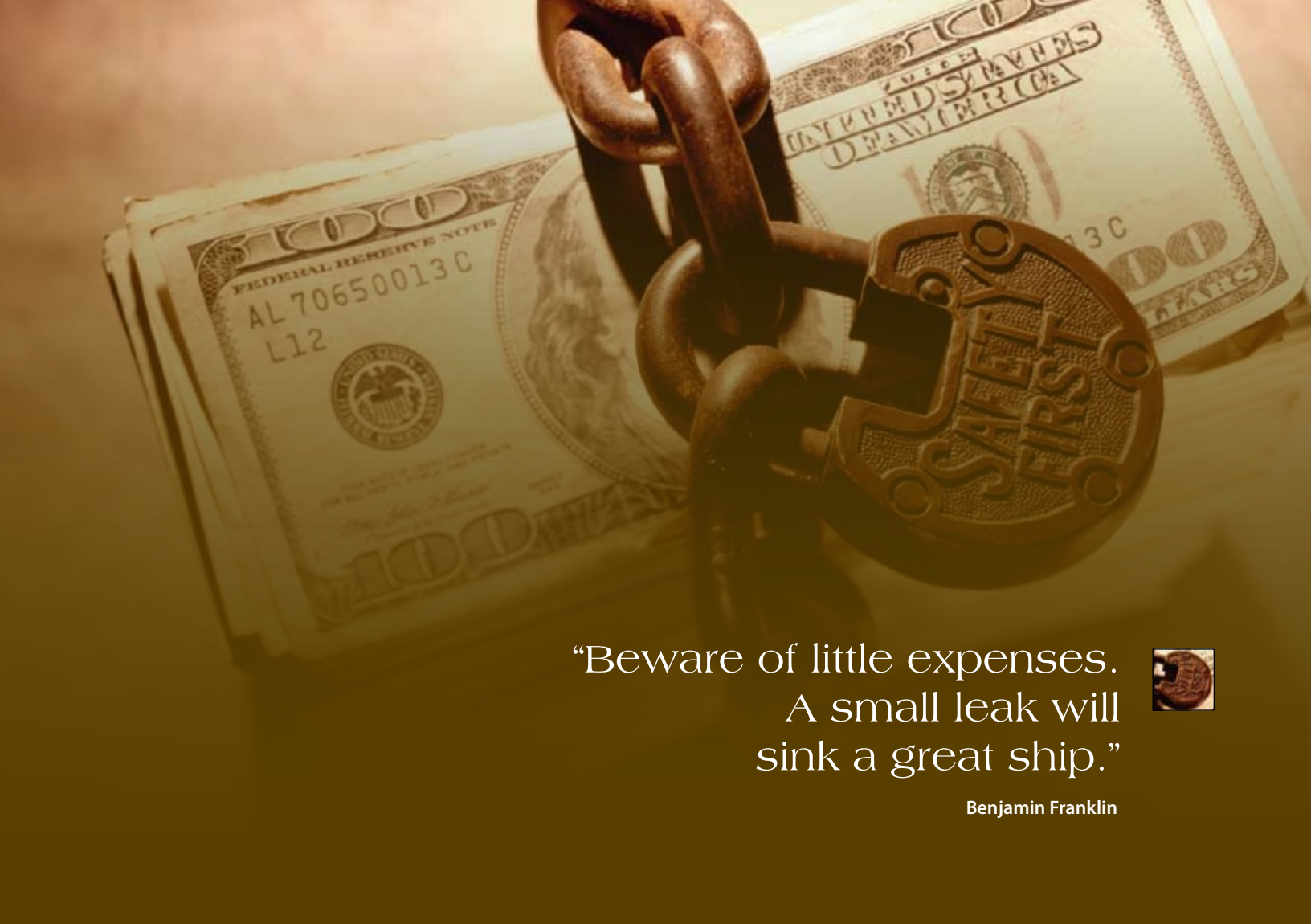
- purposes and instructions for completing each of the 10 PARR criteria for 2009-2010 in tabbed sections; and

Topics and presenters

- **PARR – Saving Money and Lost Time For Six Years**
Risk Control Manager Heather Kinard, CPSI, will review how to complete the ten requirements for SCSBIT's Premium and Risk Reduction (PARR) program to become eligible for a five percent credit on your Workers' Compensation premium for 2010-2011.
- **Lockout / Tagout – "Shockingly" Underused!**
Van Henson Training and Education Supervisor with SC OSHA Voluntary Programs will review and discuss OSHA's Lockout / Tagout Standard (OSHA 29 CFR 1910.147 - Control of Hazardous Energy). OSHA mandates that employees be trained on energy sources, methods of control, and the written programs that are specific to your School District. A sample Lockout/Tagout written program will be included in the PARR tool kit.
- **Metal Halide Lighting – What You May Not Know Can Hurt You!**
Broken and unshielded high intensity metal halide and mercury vapor light bulbs can cause eye and skin injuries, particularly in school gymnasiums. Sr. Risk Control Specialist Tim Hinson will discuss this problem and what you need to know to keep your students, staff and property safe.

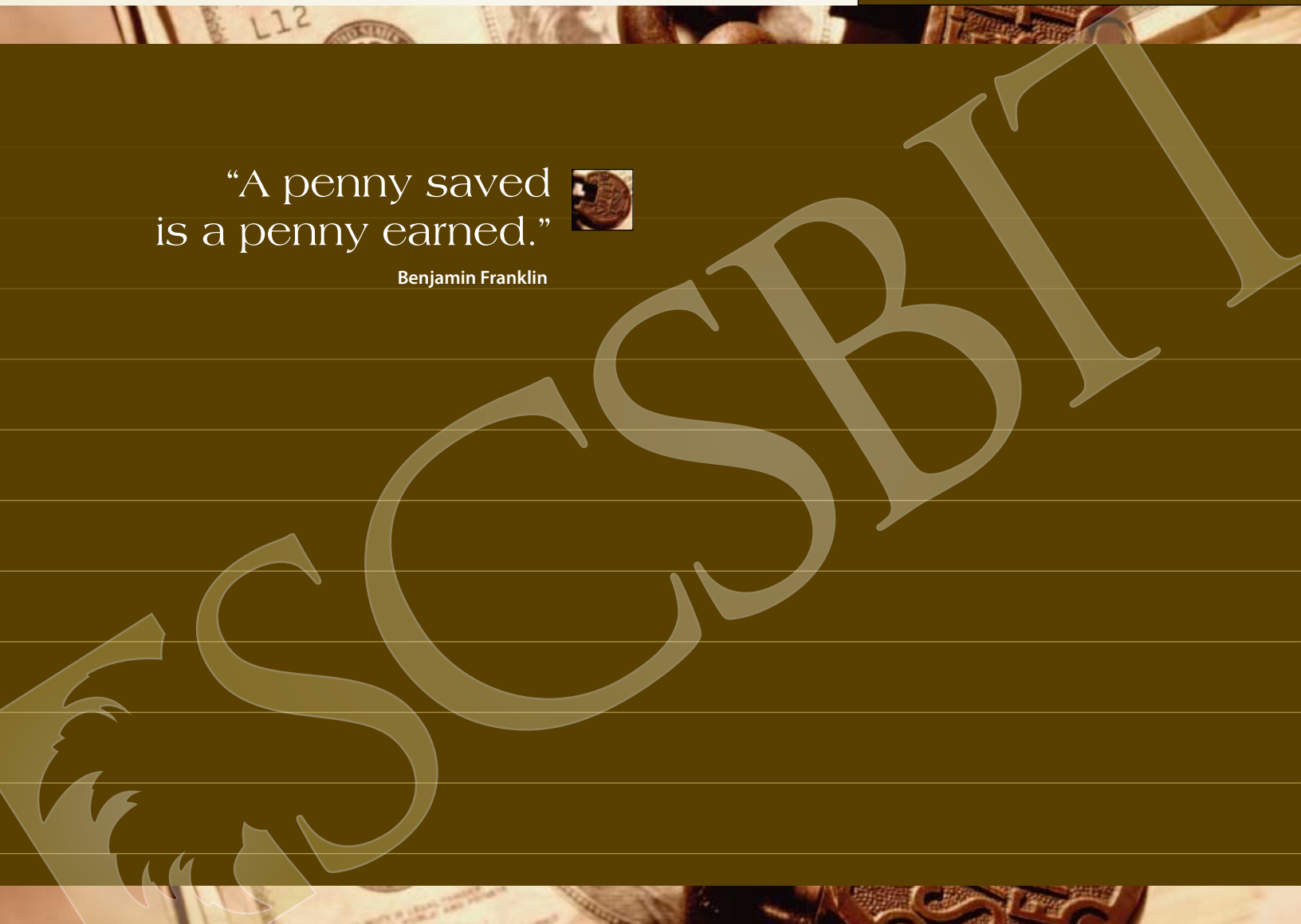
