As a leading voice for public schools, your visibility in front of our state lawmakers is more important than ever before.

School funding is in crisis and the education community must be at the table advocating for solutions. So mark your calendar and plan to participate in the South Carolina School Boards Association's 2DAC (Two Days At The Capitol) events. 2DAC is two days during the legislative session for board members, superintendents and public school advocates to:

- spend time at the State House meeting with their legislators to discuss legislation impacting public schools;
- attend legislative committee meetings; and
- increase the visibility and voice of local school boards.

Each school board is asked to send at least two members, one of whom is the Board Legislative Contact (BLC). The BLC or designee will coordinate the board's activities during the nearly two-hour visit at the State House, including scheduling meetings with legislators and/or attending any committee meetings. SCSBA will provide participants with an advance list of legislative events as they are scheduled to assist with planning.

This year's events are set for Wednesday, March 16 and Wednesday, April 27. Each day is designated for school boards in certain regions of the state as follows:

- **Wednesday, March 16** (registration deadline: March 7) for school boards in Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Beaufort, Berkeley, Calhoun, Chesterfield, Charleston, Clarendon, Colleton, Darlington, Dillon, Dorchester, Florence, Georgetown, Hampton, Horry, Jasper, Lee, Marion, Marlboro, Orangeburg, Sumter, and Williamsburg counties.
- **Wednesday, April 27** (registration deadline: April 14) for school boards in Abbeville, Aiken, Anderson, Cherokee, Chester, Edgefield, Fairfield, Greenville, Greenwood, Kershaw, Laurens, Lancaster, Lexington, Newberry, Oconee, Pickens, McCormick, Richland, Saluda, Spartanburg, and Union and York counties.
